
Please refer to your application dated 13th July, 2010 on the subject cited above. The relevant reply against your queries is as under:-

Ans.1. The Section 11 of the Copyright Act, 1957 and article 217 (2) of the Constitution of India are self-explanatory and are matter of records.

Ans. 3. The Copyright Act, 1957 and rules made thereunder are silent about the age of Chairman, Copyright Board. Section 11(3) of the Act provide that 'the Chairman of the Copyright Board shall be a person who, or has been, a Judge of a High Court or is equivalent for appointment as a Judge of High Court'.

Ans. 4. Under the Copyright Rule 3(3) the Chairman or any other Member of the Copyright Board may resign his office by giving three months notice in writing to Central Government. The tenure of the present Chairman, Copyright Board, Dr. Raghbir Singh will expire on 4th April, 2011. The Copyright Act and Rules are silent about the procedure for removal of Chairman from his post.
